She trained at Nicklaus Children's Hospital for pediatric residency, at Northwell Health, Cohen's Children's Hospital for pediatric cardiology fellowship and at University of Colorado for Congenital Interventional Cardiology.

Her clinical expertise includes the care of infants, children and adults with congenital heart disease and specifically, performing diagnostic and interventional cardiac catheterizations on these patients. Her scholarly pursuits encompass advancements within the cardiac catheterization laboratory, with a focus on cutting-edge technologies such as 3D fusion imaging, 3D printing derived from 3D rotational angiograms, and the integration of Virtual/Extended Reality in catheterization procedures. Additionally, she is deeply interested in exploring a low-radiation approach for complex percutaneous interventions, aiming to reduce contrast and fluoroscopy exposure for both patients and catheterization laboratory personnel.
